How is Junior High Different?

- **Different Classes:** You will go to a different classroom for each subject. You'll need to learn where each class is and what time it starts.

- **More Choices:** You will have opportunities to participate in a variety of extracurricular activities.
- **More Homework:** This is another part of your growing responsibility.

- **Get Organized:** Schedule time for homework and other activities. Use your agenda to keep track of assignments and scheduled activities.
- **Get Involved in School:** Join a club or take a class that interests you.
